1.1 In terms of DoPT's O.M. No. 22011/4/2013-Estt. (D) dated 08.05.2017 and para 6.4.2 (i) of the DPC guidelines, a regular DPC and 2 Supplementary DPCs were held for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' for filling up the vacancies for the panel/vacancy year 2020. In this regard, details are as under:

1.2 As informed vide self contained note, 3rd Supplementary DPC for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' is to be held for filling up 12 vacancies (2 UR + 8 SC + 2 ST) for the vacancy year 2020.

2.1 In terms of para 6.4.2 (j) of the DPC guidelines read with DoPTs O.M. No. 22011/2/2014-Estt. D dated 30.01.2015 regarding procedure for filling up further vacancies in the same year and conduct of supplementary DPC, vacancies due to death, voluntary retirement, new creations, etc. clearly belonging to the category which could not be foreseen at the time of placing facts and material before the DPC. In such cases, another meeting of the DPC should be held for drawing up a panel for these vacancies as these vacancies could not be anticipated at the time of holding the earlier DPC. If for any reason, the DPC cannot meet for the second time, the procedure of drawing up of year wise panels may be followed when it meets next for preparing panels in respect of vacancies that arise in subsequent year (s).

2.2 As per para 6.4.1 of the DPC guidelines regarding preparation of year wise panels by DPC where they have not met for a number of years, where for reasons beyond control, the DPC could not be held in a year (s), even though the vacancies arose during that year (or years), the first DPC that meets thereafter should follow the following procedures:-

- (i) Determine the actual number of regular vacancies that arose in each of the previous year (s) immediately preceding and the actual number of regular vacancies proposed to be filled in the current year separately.
 - (ii) Consider in respect of each of the years those officers only who would be within the field of choice with reference to the vacancies of each year starting with the earliest year onwards.
 - (iii) Prepare a 'Select List' by placing the select list of the earlier year above the one for the next year and so on.
- 2.3 In terms of para 6.4.3 of the DPC guidelines regarding service records to be scrutinized while preparing year wise panel, for the purpose of evaluation, the merit of the officers while preparing year wise panels, the scrutiny of the records of service of the officers should be limited to the records that would have been available had the DPC met at the appropriate time.
- 2.4 In terms of para 6.4.4 of the DPC guidelines regarding promotion with only prospective, promotion will be made in the order of the consolidated select list, such promotions will have only prospective effect even in cases where the vacancies relate to earlier year(s).
- 2.5 As per para 17.10 of the DPC guidelines regarding date from which promotion are to be treated as regular, the general principle is that, promotion of officers included in the panel would be regular from the date of validity of the panel or the date of their actual promotion, whichever is later.

3.1 As per the Recruitment Rules, 2019 forwarded by the Ministry under letter F.No.A-12018/10/2012-Ad.II (B) dated 26.08.2019, the post of Superintendent Group 'B' is to be filled up by the **selection method** and Inspectors with 2 years regular service and have successfully completed 2-4 weeks training as prescribed by the Department, are eligible to be considered for promotion to the grade of Superintendent Group 'B'. In terms of para 3.4 of DOP's O.M. No. 35034/7/97-Estt.(D) dated 08.02.2002, the **bench mark** for promotion in selection posts below the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 12000-16500 (Revised as Rs. 15600-39100 + Grade Pay of Rs. 7600), is '**Good**' and the DPC shall grade the officer as '**Fit**' or '**Unfit**' only w.r.t. the bench mark of 'Good' only. Those who are graded as '**Fit**' shall be included in the select panel prepared by the DPC in order of their inter-se-seniority in the feeder grade.

3.2 The DoP&T, New Delhi vide its O.M. No. 22011/5/86-Estt. (D), Dated 10.04.1989 issued guidelines for DPC.

- In terms of Para 6.2.1 (a) of the DPC guidelines, the DPC should consider CRs for **equal number of years** in respect of all officers considered for promotion subject to (c) below.

- In terms of Para 6.2.1 (b) of the DPC guidelines, the DPC should assess the suitability of the employees for promotion on the basis of their Service record and with particular reference to the CRs for the **five preceding years irrespective of the qualifying service** prescribed in the Service / Recruitment Rules.

- In terms of Para 6.2.1 (c) of the DPC guidelines, where one or more **CRs have not been written for any reason** during the relevant period, the DPC should consider the CRs of the years preceding the period in question.

- In terms of Para 6.2.1 (e) of the DPC guidelines, the **DPC should not be guided merely by the overall grading**, if any, that may be recorded in the CRs but **should make its own assessment on the basis of the entries** in the CRs, because it has been noticed that sometimes the overall grading in CR may be inconsistent with the grading under various parameters or attributes.

- In terms of Para 6.2.1 (f) of the DPC guidelines, if the Reviewing authority or the Accepting authority as the case may be has over-ruled the Reporting Officer or the Reviewing authority as the case may be, the remarks of the latter authority should be taken as the final remarks for the purposes of assessment provided it is apparent from the relevant entries that the higher authority has come to a different assessment consciously after due application of mind.

4. In terms of DoP&T's O.M. No. 22011/4/2013-Estt. (D) dated 08.05.2017, the **crucial date of eligibility is 1st January, 2020** for the **Vacancy Year 2020**.

5. The position of reservation roster in the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B', for filling up 12 vacancies for the vacancy year 2020, is as under :-

In view of above, out of 12 vacancies, 2 vacancies are unreserved, 8 vacancies are reserved for the SC category and 2 vacancies are reserved for ST category.

6.1. The DoP&T vide O.M. No. 22011/2/2002-Estt. (D), dated 06.01.2006 has prescribed the normal and extended zone of consideration. Further, the DoPT vide O.M. No. 22011/2/2014-Estt.(D) dated 30.01.2015 had decided that (i) **the zone of**

consideration, in case of holding supplementary DPC, shall be fixed as per the DoPT's aforesaid O.M. dated 06.01.2006 keeping in view total number of vacancies arising in a particular vacancy year i.e. vacancies accounted in Original DPC + additional vacancies becoming available subsequently during the same year. (ii) the eligibility list for supplementary DPC shall be prepared by removing the names of all such officers who have already been assessed by earlier DPC as fit, unfit or placed in the sealed cover by the original DPC before placing the same for consideration by the supplementary DPC.

6.2 As informed vide self contained note, in terms of DOPT O.M. No. 22011/2/2002-Estt (D) dated 06.01.2006 readwith DoPT vide O.M. No. 22011/2/2014-Estt.(D) dated 30.01.2015, 25 Inspectors available in the normal zone of consideration, have been taken into consideration for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' for filling up regular vacancies for the vacancy year 2020. Further, 5 SC and 3 ST Category Inspectors available in the extended zone of consideration, have also been taken into consideration for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' for filling up regular vacancies for the vacancy year 2020

6.3 Shri Manoj Kumar Bairwa (SC), Inspector is falling within the extended zone of consideration for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' for filling up the vacancies reserved for the SC category for the vacancy year 2020 but since, his initial promotion from the grade of Stenographer Grade-II (erstwhile Stenographer Grade-III) to the grade of Stenographer Grade-I, is not as per the relevant recruitment rules, therefore, in the matter, a committee was constituted and committee vide report dated 24.02.2022, recommended that **"till receipt of specific clarification from the Board in the matter, Shri Manoj Kumar Bairwa (SC), Inspector whose initial promotion to the grade of Stenographer Grade-I is disputed as discussed in above paras, may not be considered for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' and one post of Superintendent may be kept vacant for him."**

The aforesaid report/recommendations dated 24.02.2022 of the Committee, was accepted by then Chief Commissioner, CGST & CX, Jaipur Zone, Jaipur.

6.4 A legal opinion to the effect as to whether, the decision of the department for not considering the case of Shri Manoj Kumar Bairwa, Inspector for promotion to the grade of Superintendent and keeping a post vacant for him, is correct or other-wise, has been sought from the Government Counsel vide this office letter C.No.V(Law)/HQ/CAT/02/2022 dated 26.09.2022 The Government Counsel vide letter dated 26.09.2022 has opined that the decision of the department for not considering his case for promotion to the grade of Superintendent and keeping a post vacant for him is proper and correct.

In view of the above, Shri Manoj Kumar Bairwa (SC), Inspector has not been considered for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' for filling up the vacancies reserved for the SC category for the vacancy year 2020 and one post of Superintendent, is kept vacant for him. Therefore, out of 8 vacancies reserved for the SC category, one vacancy is kept vacant for Shri Manoj Kumar Bairwa (SC), Inspector.

7.1 The DoPT vide O.M No. 36012/16/2019-Estt. (Res.) dated 12.04.2022 has issued the instructions (regarding Reservation in promotions – procedure to be followed prior to effecting reservation in the matter of promotions by all departments of the Central Government) in pursuance of judgement dated 28.01.2022 of the **Hon'ble Supreme Court** of India in the case of **Jarnail Singh** and Ors. V Lachmi Narain Gupta and Ors. The para 2 of the said O.M. dated 12.04.2022 is reproduced as under:

"2 In the judgement dated 28.01.2022, the Supreme Court has set out the conditions that are to be satisfied by the Government for the purpose of implementing the policy of reservations in promotions. These conditions are:

- (i) Collection of quantifiable data regarding inadequacy of representation of Scheduled Castes and Scheduled Tribes;
- (ii) Application of this data to each cadre separately; and

(iii) If a roster exists, the unit for operation of the roster would be the cadre for which the quantifiable data would have to be collected and applied in regard to the filling up of the vacancies in the roster.

This judgement currently holds the field.

1. All the Ministries/Departments are required to ensure that the above conditions are complied with before implementing the policy of reservation in promotions and carrying out any promotions based thereon.
2. For this purpose, all Ministries/Departments are also required to ensure the following:
 - a. In terms of DoPT OM No. 43011/153/2010-Estt (res.) dated 04.01.2013, the Liaison Officer shall ensure that the reservation rosters are strictly maintained as per the instructions/guidelines, laid down in DoPT OM No. 36012/2/96-Estt (Res.), dated 02.07.1997.
 - b. In order to ensure maintenance of efficiency of administration, the DPC shall carefully assess the suitability of the officers, being considered for promotion.
 - c. The appointing authority shall issue the appointment/promotion orders only after satisfying itself that the conditions mentioned in paragraph 2 and sub para (a) & (b) of this paragraph have been fully complied with.
3. Since the **Jarnail Singh** batch of cases is pending in the Supreme Court of India, any promotion order shall be subject to further orders that may be passed by the Supreme Court in the said batch of cases.
4. All Ministries/Departments are requested to urgently bring these instructions to the notice of all their attached/ subordinate offices as also the Public Sector Undertakings and Statutory Bodies etc. for adherence and strict compliance."
- 7.2 As informed vide self contained note, the reservation rosters for promotions have been maintained as per the instructions/guidelines, laid down in DoPT OM NO. 36012/2/96-Estt. (Res.), dated 02.07.1997. The C&AG vide Circular No. 9/NGE//98 No. 108/NGE. (App.)3/97, dated 23.01.1998 had issued clarification of doubts in DoPT's O.M. No. 36012/2/96-Estt. (RES.), dated 02.07.1997. As per doubt No. 5 of said circular dated 23.01.1998, "own merit" concept is not applicable in promotions.

In view of the aforesaid instructions, if any reserved category candidate is selected for promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B', he/she will be adjusted against the reservation. In case, there is no reserved vacancy and reserved category candidate is selected on the basis of his/her seniority, he/she will, however, get promotion but will be adjusted in future when relevant reserved category vacancy will arise in the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B'.

8.1 As per para (2) of DoP&T's O.M. No. 22011/4/91-Estt. (A), dated 14.09.1992, in respect of the Government Servants – (a) **who are under suspension**, (b) **to whom a charge-sheet has been issued and the disciplinary proceedings are pending**, and (c) **against whom prosecution for a criminal charge is pending**, the DPC shall assess their suitability along with other eligible candidates without taking into consideration the disciplinary case / criminal prosecution pending. The assessment of the DPC, including 'Unfit for promotion' and the grading awarded by it will be kept in a sealed cover.

8.2 In terms of para 7 (g) of DOPT's OM No. 22011/4/2007-Estt (D) dated 28.04.2014 readwith para 13 of the DPC guidelines, in accessing the suitability of the officer on whom a penalty has been imposed, the DPC will take into account the circumstances leading to the imposition of the penalty and decided whether in the light of general service record of the officer and fact of imposition of penalty, the officer should be considered for promotion. The DPC, after due consideration, has authority to assess the officer as 'unfit' for promotion. However, where the DPC considers that despite the penalty the officer is suitable for promotion, the officer will be actually promoted only after the currency of penalty is over.

As per para 7 (i) of the said DoPT's O.M. dated 28.04.2014, while there is no illegality in denying promotion during the currency of the penalty, denying promotion in such cases after the period of penalty is over would be in violation of the provisions of Article 20 of the Constitution.

10. The DPC find that as per the Superintendent of Central Excise, Recruitment Rules, 2019 issued vide G.S.R. No. **249 dated 05.08.2019**, forwarded by the Board under letter F.No. A-12018/10/2012-Ad.IIB, dated 26.08.2019, the post of Superintendent, "Group B" is to be filled up by the "**Selection Method**". In terms of para 3.4 of DOPT's O.M. No.35034/7/97-Estt. (D), dated 08.02.2002, the bench mark for promotion in selection posts below the pre-revised pay scale of Rs. 12000-16500 (Revised as Level-12 in Pay Matrix Rs. 78800-209200), is '**Good**' and the DPC should grade the officer as 'Fit' or 'Unfit' only w.r.t. the bench mark of '**Good**' only. Those who are graded as 'Fit' are included in the select panel prepared by the DPC in order of their inter-se-seniority in the feeder grade. As per the criterion adopted by the DPC for making selection, **the candidates whose grading in all 5 ACRs are at least 'Good' without any adverse remarks, have been graded as 'Fit'**. The candidates whose grading are less than 'Good' in these 5 ACRs or with any adverse remarks in any ACR(s), have been graded as '**Unfit**' for regular promotion to the grade of Superintendent, "Group B". Further, the candidate who is undergoing the penalty period has been graded as '**Unfit**' after taken into account the circumstances leading to the imposition of the penalty and general service record of the officer.

11(i). On the basis of the said criteria for making selection for promotion to the grade of Superintendent Group "B", the recommendations of this DPC for regular promotion to the grade of Superintendent, Group 'B' for filling up **11 (2UR + 7SC + 2 ST)** regular vacancies after keeping a vacancy of SC category for Shri Manoj Kumar Bairwa (SC), Inspector for the vacancy year 2020, are as under :-
