**Subject: 'SAMVAAD' : November 2023**

Elections for the State Assembly of Rajasthan are round the corner and the effect is palpable. India, the first and a great democracy conducts the elections with much efficiency and objectivity. Arrangements are made for every single citizen to vote. As a citizen, we need to be proud of it and cherish the greatness of our nation. We are fortunate that as Government officers, we have been tasked to play a role in free and fair conduct of elections. We must undertake the role to the best of our ability.

2. We are past the financial year midway. I hope that all officers would have taken stock of the targets and achievements. A focused approach will help us not only in achieving our goals but also surpassing them.

3. On the revenue front, the momentum gained in the previous month continues. Revenue to the tune of Rs.1983 Crores has accrued during the month of October. This marks a double digit growth of 13.81% for the second consecutive month. Revenue growth rate upto the month of October-2023 has also gone up from 6.14% to 7.26%. We need to keep up the momentum by firing all cylinders of revenue mobilization.

4. In pursuance of the SOP for elections, we have intensified our road checking. Results have been encouraging. We have been able to garner additional Rs.6.87 Crores due to these efforts. Our election focus will have to be maintained for much of the November also. The experience suggests that Iron & Steel Scrap, Gutkha/Pan Masala, tiles and several other commodities are moving sans e-way bill in substantial quantities. We need to take note of it and plug evasion in these areas.

5. I am glad to share that CGST Alwar booked a case of illegal availment of ITC of Rs.5.37 crores by M/s Sant Aluminium Pvt. Ltd. A recovery of Rs.3 crores has already been effected so far. By analyzing data through ADVAIT portal, ITC of coal cess of Rs.4.55 Crores was got reversed by CGST Udaipur from M/s Hindustan Zinc

Limited. The taxpayer had availed ITC on coal cess and proportionately claimed refund but not reversed the ITC of coal cess. Another case against M/s R. S. Enterprises has also been booked by CGST Udaipur for fraudulent availment and passing on of fake ITC to the tune of Rs.11.63 crores. I commend the teams for the good work.

6. DGGI, Jaipur Zonal Unit have realized non-payment of GST of Rs.12.26 Crores on service charges collected by M/s Rajasthan Medical Services Corporation Limited for testing of medicaments. In another case of fraudulent availment and passing on of fake ITC to the tune of Rs.17.33 crores against M/s Marble City India Limited, Behror and Kishangarh, they have recovered Rs.5 Crores. We need to learn from these cases and keep strict vigil on fake ITC cases.

7. State GST have also detected a case pertaining to M/s Nagaur Mukundgarh Highways Pvt. Ltd., Udaipur involving GST of Rs.85.97 Crores. The taxpayer had not paid GST on Annuity by wrongly classifying the service under SAC Code 9967 (exempted) instead of SAC Code 9954 (taxable @18%). A recovery of Rs.30.11 Crores has been made so far in this case. Data digging of such other taxpayers by the field formations in co-ordination with NHAI is required.

8. Forty Five Inspectors have joined the field formations after completing their induction training. I welcome the officers to the world of Indirect Tax administration. The officers are quite talented. I hope they will bring laurels to the organization.

9. As we are aware the Government of India had launched "Mission Karmayogi" – the National Programme for Civil Services Capacity Building on 02.09.2020. An e-learning platform, namely **iGOT Karmayogi Platform**, has been designed for top-class online trainings under the mission. As of now, the presence of CBIC officers on the platform in terms of logging in on the portal and undertaking courses is reported to be minimal. The Board has also called for a monthly report regarding usage of iGOT Karmayogi by officials. NACIN, Jaipur is about to organize an online handholding session for Superintendents and Inspectors of this Zone to make them conversant with the platform. As capacity building is first step for performance, all Commissioners are requested to nominate suitable number of officers for the sessions.

10. The Board has announced Swachhta Awards for the Financial Year 2022-23. None of the formations of this Zone have been ranked among the best Commissionerates. However, CGST Alwar got special mention for its Swachhta works relating to 'Swachh Jal – Distribution of 22 RO Water Purifiers and Water Coolers to various Govt. Schools'. The work done by CGST Jodhpur in the area of Open Defecation Free Society (construction of 90 toilets in Govt. Schools for providing better sanitation facilities) has been observed as outstanding by the Board. I congratulate both the Commissionerates for their outstanding work. I urge all the Commissionerates to continue with the Swachhta Projects in a sustained way and take up innovative projects to meet the objectives of Swachh Bharat Mission. We need to make cleanliness a daily habit not a one day event.

11. A Khadi Outlet was set up in the office premises from 25 to 31 October under Khadi Mahotsav programme with the objective to promote Khadi and to bolster the *Atma Nirbhar Bharat Abhiyan*. Officers of this Zone actively promoted the *Vocal for*

*Local spirit by purchasing Khadi products. We are also observing Vigilance Awareness Week from 30<sup>th</sup> October to 05<sup>th</sup> November with the theme of “Say no to corruption; commit to the Nation”.*

12. I am delighted to note that Shri Jagdish Tanwar, Superintendent secured Gold Medal in Men's Double and Men's Singles (+45) in the All India Civil Service Tennis Tournament held at Udaipur in last week of September. The Government of Rajasthan has also awarded him a citation for his contribution to the game of Tennis. Following in his father's footsteps, Master Priyansh Tanwar, son of Shri Jagdish Tanwar, Superintendent also won gold medal in under 17 singles and team events in SGFI State Level Lawn Tennis Competition held in Jodhpur from 14<sup>th</sup> to 19<sup>th</sup> October. My best wishes to both for their future endeavors. Kudos to Master Divyansh Singh Naruka, son of Shri Dungan Singh, Inspector, who got a Bronze Medal in Chess competition in KVS Regional Sports Meet-2023. He has been selected for National Level Chess Championship (under 14 category) to be held in Bangalore in November, 2023. Ms. Seepika Saxena, daughter of Shri Prakash Saxena, Superintendent has once again done us proud by clinching Silver Medal in the CBSE West Zone Cluster in the 10-meter Air Rifle category. She has also qualified for participation in the National Championship. I wish for her astounding success in the upcoming tournaments.


