Subject: Scheme for funding of Annual Health Checkup for Group 'B' and Group 'C' officials of age 40 years and above working under CBIC from the Customs & Central Excise Welfare Fund – regarding.

On the above cited subject, It is stated that the Pr. Director General, DGHRD, CBIC, New Delhi vide D.O. dated 16.01.2020 (copy enclosed) informed that a Scheme for financing the **Annual Medical Examination for Group 'B' and Group 'C' Officers / Staff working under CBIC** had been approved by the Governing Body of the Welfare Fund. The Scheme covers all the tests which are available to the Group 'A' Officers under Annual Medical Examination being implemented by the DoPT. The Scheme is applicable to all Group 'B' and 'C' Officers/Staff of age 40 years and above. The Annual Medical Examination of the officers/staff is subject to the ceiling of Rs. 2000/- and Rs. 2200/- for men and women officers respectively or actual whichever is less.

2. It was decided by the DGHRD to implement the Scheme at the level of Zonal Principal Chief Commissioner / Chief Commissioner, the Cadre Controlling Authorities of the anticipated beneficiaries, who will enter into 'Memorandum of Agreement' with CGHS empanelled Hospitals / Diagnostic Centers, or Hospitals / Diagnostic Centers recognized under CS (MA) Rules. Where there are no CGHS facilities, MoAs shall be entered into with reputed quality local Hospitals / Diagnostic Centers on the lines of MoAs entered by Ministry of Health and Family Welfare to empanel them for conducting the requisite tests of eligible departmental officials of Group 'B' and 'C', subject to the ceiling rates.

3. Consequently, vide letter F. No. InW/WF-1/MA/12/2020-WLFR-O/o ADG-I and DGHRD-Delhi dated 18.09.2020 (copy enclosed), the DGHRD revised the timelines specified for implementation of the aforesaid Scheme, as under :-

4. As per directions contained in para-2(iv) of the aforesaid D.O. dated 16.01.2020 of the DG, HRD, a list of total 786 Group 'B' and Group 'C' officers, provided by the Superintendent, Cadre Control Unit, CCO, JZ, Jaipur vide letter dated 14.02.2020 (copy enclosed) of 40 years and above as on 1st April, 2020, who are eligible for Annual Medical Examination under the said Scheme, is enclosed herewith.

5. Further, copy of Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) entered with the following CGHS / CS(MA) recognized or reputed quality local hospitals / diagnostic centers, is enclosed, who have agreed to undertake all the tests which are available to the Group 'A' Officers under Annual Medical Examination being implemented by the DoPT, on the prescribed rates of Rs. 2000/- and Rs. 2200/- for men and women officers respectively :-

- (i) Manipal Hospital, (a unit of Manipal Health Enterprises Pvt. Ltd.) Jaipur
- (ii) Bhandari Hospital & Research Centre, Jaipur
- (iii) Fortis Escorts Hospital, Jaipur
- (iv) Medipulse Hospitals, Jodhpur
- (v) Goyal Hospital & Research Centre Pvt. Ltd., Jodhpur
- (vi) Geetanjali Medical College & Hospital, Udaipur

6. All the eligible Departmental officials of Group 'B' and Group 'C' shall undergo the requisite tests in the said hospitals / diagnostic centers latest by 28.02.2021. The Hospital / Diagnostic Centre shall hand over a copy of complete Medical Report & the summary of the medical report to the officer, and the officer shall give a satisfaction rating to the facility, while submitting his bill to the Administrative Authority.

7. The HoD shall ensure that all eligible officials undergo the Annual Medical Examination by the prescribed timeline. The bills from the empanelled hospitals / diagnostic centers shall be duly examined and verified by the HoDs based on which, a consolidated Demand for grant alongwith a report detailing the eligible officials and the officials who have actually undergone the Medical Examination, and a consolidated satisfaction report as mentioned in the aforesaid D.O. dated 16.01.2020, shall be forwarded by the Commissioners, to this office latest by 31.03.2021 for onward submission to the DGHRD, for sanction and release of funds from Welfare Fund.

8. It is also requested that wider publicity for Annual Medical Examination for Group 'B' and 'C' may please be done.

This issues with the approval of the Chief Commissioner, GST & CX, Jaipur Zone.

Sub: Scheme for funding of Annual Medical Examination of Group 'B' and Group 'C' Departmental officials of age 40 and above from the Customs & Central Excise Welfare Fund-reg.

Kind attention is invited to the D.O. letter F. No. 712/170/HRD/WF-I/19 issued by DG, HRD on 17.01.2020 and a subsequent letter by the under-signed on 26.05.2020 on the subject mentioned above.

2. In terms of the implementation of the captioned Scheme, the Zonal Pr. Chief Commissioners/ Pr. Directors General/ Chief Commissioners/ Directors General were required to enter into Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with the reputed Hospitals/ Diagnostic Centers on the lines of MoAs entered into by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare to empanel them for conducting the requisite tests of eligible departmental officials of Group 'B' and Group 'C' subject to the prescribed ceiling rates latest by **31st March, 2020** (extended till **31st July, 2020** by the letter of the under-signed dated 26.05.2020).

3. However, understandably, due to the continued spread of COVID-19 throughout India, this important pre-requisite of entering into Memorandum of Agreement (MoA) with reputed Hospitals/ Diagnostic Centers on the lines of MoAs entered by Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, for implementation of the Scheme, could not be completed by any Zone.

4. Accordingly, the time-lines as specified in the aforementioned D.O. letter and extended vide letter dated 26.05.2020 from the under-signed are being again extended for the year 2020-21:
