**MINUTES OF MEETING OF THE SCREENING COMMITTEE HELD ON**  
**31.01.2025 FOR CONSIDERATION OF THE PENDING CASES FOR**  
**COMPASSIONATE APPOINTMENT**

This Committee has been informed vide note dated 30.01.2025 that a meeting of the prescribed Committee constituted vide this office Order No. CCU-03/2024 dated 26.06.2024 for making recommendations of 7 most deserving candidates amongst 18 pending cases for appointment on compassionate grounds against 7 available vacancies was held on 25.09.2024. The Committee in its Minutes of the Meeting dated 25.09.2024, after detailed assessment of all the 18 cases placed before it for Compassionate Appointment, recommended 7 candidates for compassionate appointment & 11 cases have been recommended for keeping pending for consideration by next Committee.

2. Reportedly the Minutes of the Meeting dated 25.09.2024 of the aforesaid Committee were submitted before the Chief Commissioner, CGST & CX, Jaipur Zone, Head of Department for approval. The recommendations in respect of 6 candidates as mentioned at Sr. No. 2 to 7 of Para 8 of the Minutes of the Committee dated 25.09.2024 have been approved by the Chief Commissioner. In respect of remaining 1 candidate namely Smt. Santosh Devi, mentioned at Sr. No. 1 of Para 8 of the Minutes of the Committee dated 25.09.2024, the observations of the Chief Commissioner are as under:

*"In the case of Smt. Santosh Devi (S.No.1), the D.O.B. is based on Aadhaar Card. Please examine if this is acceptable?"*

3. The Committee has gone through the clarification issued by the Director, Unique Identification Authority of India under F. No. HQ-13065/1/2022-AUTH-H HQ dated 23.04.2024. The Committee observed that an Aadhaar number can be used for establishing identity of an individual subject to authentication; however, in itself, it is not a proof of date of birth.

4. The jurisdictional Assistant Commissioner, CGST Division-J, Ajmer was requested to provide duly certified copies of valid documents in support of Date of Birth & Educational Qualification mentioned by Smt. Santosh Devi, W/o Late Shri Banshi Lal Joshi in application form submitted by her for compassionate appointment.

5. In response, the jurisdictional Assistant Commissioner, CGST Division-J, Ajmer vide letter dated 05.12.2024 has forwarded a copy of PAN Card of Smt. Santosh Devi in support of her Date of Birth. Further, in support of educational qualification, a copy of Affidavit dated 04.12.2024, duly notarized, wherein Smt. Santosh Devi has undertaken that " यह कि मैंने वर्ष 1978 में कक्षा 3 आंगनवाड़ी केंद्र, जयपुर से पास की थी, जिसकी अंकतालिका कहीं गुम हो गई है तथा काफी तलाश करने के बावजूद भी अंकतालिका नहीं मिल रही है तथा जिस आंगनवाड़ी केंद्र, जयपुर से मैंने कक्षा 3 उत्तीर्ण की थी, वह सालों पहले बंद हो गया है" has been provided.

6. The Committee has again thoroughly examined all the documents available on record and placed before it in respect of Smt. Santosh Devi. The documents submitted alongwith the application Viz., the copy of ration card, application form, affidavit dated 28.07.2021 and nomination form for Death-CUM-Retirement Gratuity all reveal different ages, thus creating ambiguity. The details of Age/ Date of Birth in various documents mentioned above are as under:

7. The Committee also observed that as per the affidavit dated 04.12.2024 she was five years old as per the date of birth shown in PAN card and she had passed 3<sup>rd</sup> standard which raises question mark and further creates doubt in respect of her actual age or date of birth. The actual Date of Birth of the applicant cannot be ascertained and correlated with the various documents provided by the applicant alongwith application form create further ambiguity.

8. In absence of the valid Date of Birth evidence and failure of the applicant to provide valid Date of Birth document and the document in support of her educational qualification, the Committee is of the opinion that in absence of any valid documents to ascertain her actual date of birth it withdraws its recommendation given in respect

of Smt. Santosh Devi as in Minutes of Meeting dated 25.09.2024. The Committee recommends that the case of Smt. Santosh Devi for appointment on compassionate grounds may be closed finally.

9. Accordingly, the Committee further recommends that against one post lying vacant in Compassionate Appointment Quota (Total post 7- candidates offered appointment on compassionate grounds & joined 6) may be filled by the candidate who has been assessed by the Committee at Sr. No. 8 of Para 8 of the Minutes of the Committee dated 25.09.2024 after analyzing him on the score of 100 points, if he is otherwise found fit.

This Committee has been informed vide note that 18 cases (11 cases kept pending by the last Committee dated 07.09.2022, 6 fresh cases and 1 case where applicant was minor at the time of meeting of last Committee & is now major) are pending for consideration for appointment on compassionate grounds. The Committee has been further informed that presently in Jaipur Zone, 7 vacancies are available in Compassionate Appointment quota.

2. The DOPT vide O.M. No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013 had issued the consolidated instructions on compassionate appointment under the Central Government. The salient points of the OM are as under:

(i) As per Para-1 of said O.M., the object of the scheme is to grant appointment on compassionate grounds to a dependent family member of a Government servant dying in harness or who is retired on medical grounds, thereby leaving his family in penury and without any means of livelihood, to relieve the family of the Government servant concerned from financial destitution and to help it get over the emergency.

(ii) As per Note-I of Para-2 of O.M. ibid, 'dependent family member' means: (a) spouse, or (b) son (including adopted son), or (c) daughter (including adopted daughter), or (d) brother or sister in the case of unmarried Government servant, who was wholly dependent on the Government servant at the time of his death in harness or retirement on medical grounds, as the case may be.

(iii) As per Para 3(b) of O.M. ibid, Head of the Department under the Supplementary Rule 2 (10) in the case of attached and subordinate offices is the authority competent to make compassionate appointment.

(iv) As per Para 4 of O.M. ibid, compassionate appointment can be made in Group 'C' posts against the direct recruitment quota. Further, as per Para 7 (b) of O.M. ibid,

compassionate appointment can be made upto a maximum of 5% of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in any Group 'C' post. In terms of Para 7(d), the ceiling of 5% of direct recruitment vacancies for making compassionate appointment should not be exceeded by utilizing any other vacancy e.g. sports quota vacancy.

(v) As per Para 5 (b) of O.M. ibid, applicant for compassionate appointment should be eligible and suitable for the post in all respects under the provisions of the relevant Recruitment Rules.

(vi) As per Para 6 (A) of O.M. ibid, compassionate appointments are exempted from observance of the following requirements:

- (a) Recruitment procedure i.e. without the agency of the Staff Selection Commission or the Employment Exchange.
- (b) Clearance from the Surplus Cell of the DOPT/Directorate General of Employment and Training.
- (c) The ban orders on filling up of posts issued by the Ministry of Finance (Deptt. of Expenditure).

(vii) Further, as per Para 6(B) of O.M. ibid, (a) upper age limit could be relaxed wherever found to be necessary. The lower age limit should, however, in no case be relaxed below 18 years of age. Age eligibility shall be determined with reference to the date of application and not the date of appointment. Authority competent to take a final decision for making compassionate appointment in a case shall be competent to grant relaxation of upper age limit also for making such appointment. As per Para 6-B of O.M. ibid, (b) in exceptional circumstances Government may consider recruiting persons not immediately meeting the minimum educational standards. Government may engage them as trainees who will be given the regular pay bands and grade pay only on acquiring the minimum qualification prescribed under the recruitment rules. In the case of an attached / subordinate office, the Secretary in the concerned administrative Ministry/ department shall be the competent authority for this purpose.

(viii) Further, as per Para 6-B of O.M. ibid, (d) in case of appointment of a widow not fulfilling the requirement of educational qualification, against the post of Multi Tasking Staff, she will be placed in Group 'C' Pay Band – 1 + Grade Pay Rs. 1800/- directly without insisting on fulfillment of educational qualification norms, provided the appointing authority is satisfied that the duties of the post against which she is being appointed can be performed with help of some on job training. This dispensation is to be allowed for appointment on compassionate ground against the post of MULTI TASKING STAFF only.

(ix) As per Para 7 (a) & 7 (b) of O.M. ibid, appointment on compassionate grounds should be made only on regular basis and that too only if regular vacancies meant for that purpose are available. Compassionate appointment can be made upto a maximum of 5 % of vacancies falling under direct recruitment quota in any Group 'C' post.

(x) As per Para 7 (e) of O.M. ibid, the Committee constituted for considering a request for appointment on compassionate grounds should limit its recommendation to appointment on compassionate grounds only in a really deserving case and only if vacancy meant for appointment on compassionate grounds will be available within a year in the concerned administrative Ministry/Department/Office, that too within the ceiling of 5% of vacancies falling under Direct Recruitment quota in any Group 'C' posts.

(xi) As per Para 8 of O.M. ibid, in respect of time limit for considering applications for Compassionate Appointment, the DOPT has clarified with issue of instructions vide OM No. 14014/3/2011-Estt.(D) dated 26.07.2012 that subject to availability of a vacancy, there is no time limit for consideration of request for appointment on compassionate grounds which is to be considered on merit and to take decision on merit of case.

(xii) As per Para 9 of O.M. ibid, (a) belated requests for compassionate appointments can be considered by the Ministries/Departments even where the death/retirement on medical grounds of a Government servant took place long back say 5 years or so. However, examination of such cases would all for a great deal of circumspection as the family has been able to manage somehow all these years, should be taken as adequate proof that family had some dependable means of subsistence while concept of compassionate appointment is related to immediate assistance to the family of deceased. The decision to make appointment on compassionate grounds in such cases may therefore be taken only at the level of Secretary of the Department/Ministry concerned.

(b) Whether a request for Compassionate appointment is belated or not may be decided with reference to the date of death or retirement on medical ground of a Government servant and not the age of the applicant at the time of consideration.

(c) The onus of examining the penurious condition of the dependent family will rest with the authority making compassionate appointment.

(xiii) As per Para 11(a) of O.M. ibid, in deserving cases even where there is already an earning member in the family, a dependent family member may be considered for compassionate appointment with prior approval of the Secretary of the Department/Ministry concerned who, before approving such appointment, will satisfy himself that grant of compassionate appointment is justified having regard to number of dependents, assets and liabilities left by the Government servant, income of the earning member as also his liabilities including the fact that the earning member is residing with the family of the Government servant and whether he should not be a source of support to other members of the family.

(xiv) As per Para 11(b) of O.M. ibid, in cases where any member of the family of the deceased or medically retired government servant is already in employment and is not supporting the other members of the family of the government servant, extreme caution has to be observed in ascertaining the economic distress of the members of the family of the government servant so that the facility of appointment on compassionate ground is not circumvented and misused by putting forward the ground that the member of the family already employed is not supporting the family.

(xv) As per revised instruction issued under para 13 of OM ibid vide DOPT OM No. No. 43019/9/2019-Estt.(D) Dated 23.08.2021, every valid application shall be assessed strictly on the basis of the point based merit system formulated by the concerned administrative Ministry/Department.

(xvi) As per Para 13 of O.M. ibid/ revised Para-13(viii) vide O.M. No. 43019/9/2019-Estt.(D) Dated 23.08.2021, to consider various applications and to recommend individual applicant for grant of compassionate appointment a Committee may be constituted consisting of three members – one Chairman and two Members – of rank of Deputy Secretary/Director in the Ministry/Department and officers of equivalent rank in the case of attached and subordinate offices. Further, the committee should make its recommendation for appointment on compassionate ground as per the total points obtained by each Applicant, under the applicable point based merit system. Recommendation of the Committee should be placed before the competent authority for a decision. If the competent authority disagrees with the Committee's recommendation, the case may be referred to the next higher authority for a decision.

(xvii) As per Para-18 of O.M. ibid, appointments made on grounds of compassion should be done in such a way that persons appointed to the post do have the essential educational and technical qualification and experience required for the post consistent with the requirement of maintenance of efficiency of administration. Further, in terms of para 18(c) of the scheme, while considering a request for appointment on compassionate ground, a balanced and objective assessment of the financial condition of the family has to be made taking into account its assets and liabilities

(including the benefits received under the various welfare schemes) and all other relevant factors such as the presence of an earning member, size of the family, ages of the children and the essential needs of the family etc. Requests for compassionate appointment consequent on death or retirement on medical grounds of erstwhile Group 'D' staff may be considered with greater sympathy by applying relaxed standards depending on the facts and circumstances of the case.

3. The instructions on Compassionate Appointment issued from time to time have been compiled by DoPT. The updated instructions as on 02.08.2022 are available on website of DoPT. The Committee has also gone through the same.

4. Further, the Central Board of Excise & Customs, New Delhi vide its letter F. No. 18013/04/2016-AD.IIIB dated 28.08.2017 has forwarded a copy of DOPT's O.M. No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 05.09.2016 regarding review of FAQ No. 13 dated 30.05.2013 and FAQ No. 60 dated 25.02.2015 with regard to married son. Vide above said letter, the Under Secretary has stated that the DOPT has reviewed the clarification/FAQ No. 13 dated 30.05.2013 and FAQ No. 60 dated 25.02.2015 in consultation with the Department of Legal Affairs and decided that married son can be considered for compassionate appointment if he otherwise fulfills all the other requirements of the scheme i.e. he is otherwise eligible and fulfills the criteria laid down in the DOPT O.M. dated 16.01.2013.

5. Further, the CBIC, New Delhi vide letter F.No.A.12012/52/2018-Ad.III.B dated 15.05.2019 has introduced Relative Merit Point & revised procedure for selection under scheme for Compassionate Appointment. In order to ensure complete transparency, merits of the cases is now to be decided by allocating points to the applicants based on various attributes based on a 100 Point Scale as proposed vide the said letter along with details mentioned for allocation of Points in Proforma 'C'. A Table has been enclosed in the said letter for allocation of Points with proposed slabs for each attribute related to deceased employee i.e. length of service, terminal benefits, Income from Property, Annual income of family, liabilities etc., on the basis of that, Points will be allotted to the applicants and merit will be decided accordingly. A complete list of Tables and relative Points Summary is as under:

\* In addition to the above, cases where the wife of deceased official has applied for compassionate appointment for herself, she shall get 15 additional points as grace points. She will be in line with the general principal that the widow needs to be given preference for compassionate appointment.

**5(i)** Further, in order to decide the merit among applicants who have same points, a tie breaking formula based on "per dependent available income" has been suggested by the Board vide letter F.No.A.12012/8/2020-Ad.III.B dated 14.12.2020. To get tie breaking factor, total of first three financial parameters prescribed in SOP (Pension-annualised, total terminal benefits and annual income of earning members and income from property) divided by total number of dependants (spouse, parents, dependent married/ unmarried / widowed/ divorced daughters, dependent minor children of deceased Government Servant OR dependent sister(s) /brother(s) of an unmarried deceased Government Servant, unmarried major son below 25 years & dependant major sons who are physically/mentally challenged). The lesser the per dependent available income, the higher the rank amongst the applicants whose scores had a tie.

In case of tie even after applying the factor of per dependent available income, then the left-over service of Government Servant can be considered. This is suggested as it is felt that longer the left - over service of the deceased, the more is the impact on the family. Applicants related to Government servant with higher left-over service would be considered over the one with lesser left-over service. In case of tie even then, the next factor can be No. of physically/mentally challenged dependents & unmarried/divorced daughter(s). In case of tie even then, the next factor can be age of the applicant, with elder applicants given preference.

The tie breaking factor(s) as given in said letter should be used only to decide relative merit of the applicants scoring same points on 100-point scale and only if the applicants scoring same points cannot be accommodated against available vacancies.

**5(ii)** Further, the Board vide this letter dated 14.12.2020 also recommended for substitution of the entries made at point No. 7 & 8 in 100-point scale of SOP issued vide letter No. A.12012/52/2018- Ad.IIIB dated 15.09.2019 by the following entries:

(7) "Dependent married/unmarried/widowed/ divorced daughters of deceased Government Servant"

The Committee has preliminarily examined all the 18 cases placed before it for Compassionate Appointment in its meeting held on 25.07.2024 keeping in mind the DOPT's instructions regarding appointment on compassionate grounds issued vide O.M. No. 14014/02/2012-Estt.(D) dated 16.01.2013 read with OM dated 02.08.2022, Ministry's letter F. No. A.18013/04/2016-Ad.IIIB dated 28.08.2017, F. No. A.12012/52/2018-Ad.III.B dated 15.05.2019, F. No. A.12012/8/2020-Ad.III.B dated 14.12.2020 and other instructions issued from time to time by the DOPT/Ministry regarding compassionate appointment. The Committee in its meeting dated 25.07.2024 observed that in 9 cases, property has been shown by the applicants or the value of the property has been shown without any supporting documents viz. Patwari Report/ Valuer Report etc. Therefore, the Committee in its Minutes dated 25.07.2024 recommended to obtain proper valuation reports in respect of immovable properties shown by the said 9 applicants. Now, the Committee has been informed that the information desired by the Committee vide Minutes dated 25.07.2024 has been received from the jurisdictional Commissionerates. The same has been placed before the Committee. The Committee has gone through further reports received from the Commissionerates alongwith documents already available on records.

8. The Committee has thoroughly analyzed & assessed each case in terms of extant instructions & following the merit point formula as presented in the Ministry's letter dated 15.05.2019. The Committee has marked its assessment in respect of each applicant in Proforma 'C', duly verified by Chairman & both the Members. The Committee is of opinion that more the marks on the scale of 100, poorer the condition of the family. Therefore, the Committee has arranged the cases in decreasing order of points obtained on scale of 100 so as to make its recommendations looking into number of vacancies available in Compassionate Appointment Quota. As regards applicants at Sr. No. 2 & 3 below, the Committee assessed 53 points each in respect of both of them. Further, the applicants at Sr. No. 7 & 8 also secured identical scores i.e. 46. Similarly, applicants at Sr. No. 13 & 14 have been assessed 39 points each on the scale of 100 points. Therefore, the Committee has followed the instructions contained in the Board's letter dated 14.12.2020 regarding 'Tie Breaking formula' so as to award them proper rank. After detailed assessment as per given formula, as mentioned in the Annexure-A, B & C to these minutes, the Committee has awarded them rank based on "per dependent available income" arrived following the tie breaking formula. Applicant wise assessment & recommendation are as under:



This Committee has been constituted by the Chief Commissioner, CGST & CE (Jaipur Zone), Jaipur vide Office Order No. CCU-03/2024 dated 26.06.2024 for preliminary screening of all the pending cases of compassionate appointment against seven vacancies under compassionate appointment quota and to recommend the most suitable candidates in terms of standing rules and guidelines issued by the DoPT and CBIC.

2. This committee has been informed vide note that 18 cases (11 kept pending by the last Committee whose meeting held on 07.09.2022 + 7 fresh cases including 1 case where applicant was minor at the time of last meeting of the Committee) of compassionate appointment are to be screened for recommending 7 deserving candidates for appointment on compassionate grounds against 7 posts in Compassionate Appointment Quota.

3. The Committee has thoroughly assessed all the 18 cases on the basis of documents available on record & placed before the Committee. The Committee has assessed the relative merit points obtained by respective applicants as detailed in Part 'C' of "Proforma regarding employment of dependents of Government servants dying while in service/retired on invalid pension" in terms of CBIC letter F.No.12012/52/2018-Ad.III.B dated 15.05.2019 read with letter dated 14.12.2020.

4. On scrutiny of 18 cases for compassionate appointment placed before the Committee, the Committee observed that in 9 cases, as detailed below, either 'NIL' property has been shown by the applicants or the value of the property has been shown without any supporting documents viz. Patwari Report/ Valuer Report etc. Further, as regards the case of Shri Shivam Verma S/o Late Shri Rakesh Kumar Verma, reportedly the property is in the name of mother of the deceased employee
