Dear *Colleague,*

Subject: SAMVAAD : September 2023

I am glad to have joined as Chief Commissioner of CGST & CX, Jaipur Zone on 21.08.2023. I have pleasant memories from my first stint at Rajasthan. I hope to build on my previous experiences and look forward to working with you all once again.

2. The Zone has collected a revenue of Rs.1,708 Crores for the month of August, 2023 which is a rise of 8.45% over the corresponding month of previous financial year. Upto the month of August, 2023, there is an increase of Rs.302 Crores (3.47%) as compared to the last F.Y. We need to gear up ourselves to realize our target of Rs. 23,300 Crores for the F.Y. 2023-24.

3. I am glad to share that CGST Commissionerate, Jaipur has booked a seizure of Tobacco Products i.e. Kamla Pasand Pan Masala, Rajshree Pan Masala, Safal Zarda etc. valued at Rs.1.50 Crores against M/s Aditya Sales Agencies, Jaipur and recovered tax and penalty of approx. Rs.52 Lacs so far. In this case unaccounted Indian currency of Rs.22.63 Lakhs was also seized. In addition, the Commissionerate has also booked two cases of fake invoices with a recovery of Rs.95 Lakhs so far. Further, CGST Commissionerate, Jodhpur have effected a recovery of Rs.7.45 Crore in the month of August, 2023 in the case of M/s Siemens Gamesa Renewable Power Private Limited, Jaisalmer.

4. DGGI, Jaipur have also booked three cases in the previous month. In one case of wrongful availment of ITC on fake invoices of Marble Blocks/ Luffers received without supply of underlying goods. Detection of Rs.15.08 Crores and recovery of Rs.9.08 Crores has been made from M/s Baba Super Minerals Pvt. Ltd. and M/s Baba Minerals. Further, on issue of non-payment of GST for rendering taxable services by M/s Rajasthan University of Health Sciences, Jaipur, a case has been booked with detection of Rs.30.53 Crores and recovery of Rs.3.64 Crores. Another case has been booked against M/s Dedicated Freight Corridor Corporation of India Limited with a detection of Rs.22.49 Crores. We need to take note of these cases and tone up our intelligence in these areas too.

5. The Board is working on launching of the revamped and upgraded e-HRMS Version 2.0. I request the Commissioners to expedite the completion of preparatory work as communicated by this office letter dated 29.08.2023 for successful execution of the project.

6. I take this opportunity to commend Shri Rajesh, Inspector, CGST, Bhilwara for his initiative 'Mission Bargad'. His team has planted more than 800 Banyan trees in and around the CGST Garden at Kuchaman City. I am also informed that Shri Rajesh has been selected as an external expert for sharing his ideas for the landscaping of NACIN, Palasamudram.

7. I am delighted to share that Miss Seepika Saxena, daughter of Shri Prakash Saxena, Superintendent has won One Gold and Two Silver Medals in the Rajasthan State Shooting Championship in 10 Mtrs. Air Rifle Event. She has made the CGST family proud.


8. On the HR front, I am glad that we have been able to issue promotion orders in the grade of Superintendent from Inspector. We also expect newly trained Inspectors to join the team in the month of October. Therefore, very soon we will be in a better position to take off in our Key Result Areas. We need to dedicate ourselves for achieving the targets set by the Board with greater vigour.

9. I would like to extend my heartfelt best wishes to Shri Purushottam Das Lalwani, Chief Accounts Officer, Shri Bharat Lal Meena, Superintendent and Shri Bhairu Lal Jhalawat, Superintendent on their superannuation. It was heartening to note that senior officers made personal efforts to ensure that Shri P. D. Lalwani got his promotion in time.
