Sub.: Regarding clarification on grant of financial upgradation under the Modified Assured Career Progression Scheme.

Please refer to CBEC's letter F.No. A-26017/123/2017-AdIIA dated 07.06.2017 on the above captioned subject in response to this office letter of even number 607 dated 04.06.2014 (copy enclosed) regarding clarification on the MACP Scheme.

2. In this context, as desired vide aforesaid letter dated 07.06.2017, please find enclosed herewith a list of eligible 104 officers mentioning their service history for consideration of their cases for grant of 2nd or 3rd financial upgradation under the MACPS counting 10 years regular service in the grade of Inspector on notional promotion w.e.f. 06.12.2002.

3. Further, the self contained proposal in the matter is as under :-

(i) As per the MACP Scheme and clarifications, there shall be three financial upgradations under the MACPs, counted from the direct entry grade on completion of 10, 20 and 30 years service respectively. Financial upgradation under the Scheme will be admissible whenever a person has spent 10 years continuously in the same grade-pay.

(ii) In compliance of Order dated 02.03.2006 in W.P. No. 7963/2004 passed by Hon'ble Andhra Pradesh High Court as directed by the CBEC vide letters F. No. A-32022/70/2003-Ad.III.A dated 17.05.2006, F. No. A-32022/70/2003-Ad.III.A dated 19.07.2006 readwith Recruitment Rules of Inspector, Central Excise, 1979 and other related instructions, 129 Tax Assistants (old), UDCs, Stenographers, etc. were granted regular promotion to the grade of Inspector (including those candidates who were granted regular or adhoc promotion to the grade of Inspector after 06.12.2002) w.e.f. 06.12.2002 on notional basis after selection by the Review DPCs subject to the outcome of SLPs filed by Sh. D. Raghu & Others., under the Estt. Orders dated 20.07.2006, 08.11.2006, 22.08.2008, 14.12.2010.

(iii). The said Inspectors have completed 10 years on 06.12.2012 in the same pay scale (revised) i.e. Grade Pay of Rs. 4600 in PB-2. Many inspectors who had earned

first or second regular promotion to the grade of Inspector w.e.f. 06.12.2002 on notional basis as discussed above, have submitted the representations for grant of 2nd or 3rd financial upgradation to the grade pay of Rs. 4800 in PB-2 w.e.f. 06.12.2012 i.e. on completion of 10 years from the date of regular promotion to the post of Inspector on notional basis i.e. 06.12.2002.

(iv). In the matter, the clarification on doubts (i) and (ii) as mentioned also in the CBEC's aforesaid letter dated 07.06.2017, were sought by this office vide aforesaid letter dated 04.06.2014 with reference to CBEC's letter F.No. A-26017/23/2012-Ad.IIA dated 20.07.2012.

(v). It is to mention here that as per para-18.4.3 of the DPC guidelines regarding review DPC, the officer who is selected by the review DPC, is promoted immediately from the date when the officer immediately below him was promoted. It is also mentioned in the said para that in such case, a minimum period of qualifying service is prescribed for promotion to the higher grade, the period from which an officer placed below the officer concerned in the select list was promoted to the higher grade, should be reckoned towards the qualifying period of service for the purpose of determining his eligibility for promotion to the next higher grade.


4. Since, in terms of the said para-18.4.3 of the DPC guidelines, the required regular service for consideration for promotion to the higher cadre is determined from the date of **notional promotion**, therefore, this office is of the view that the required 10 years of regular service for grant of financial upgradation under the MACPS should also be counted from the date of notional promotion.

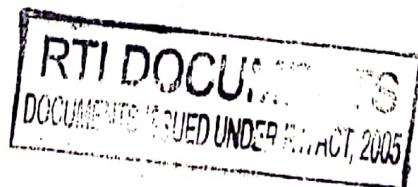
5. In view of above, necessary approval for consideration of the aforesaid pending cases in respect of eligible 104 officers for grant of 2nd or 3rd financial upgradation under the MACPS w.e.f. 06.12.2012 counting 10 years of service from the date of notional promotion to the grade of Inspector w.e.f. 06.12.2002 as done by some other zones, may kindly be granted at an early date.

An early reply in the matter is solicited.

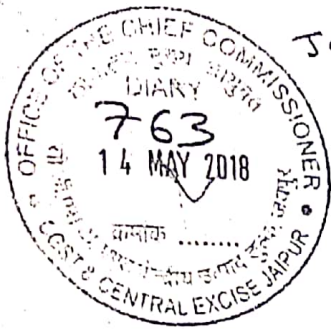

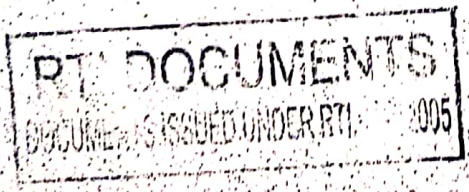
